What region/town are you from in Italy? Abruzzo

What year did you arrive in Australia? 1969

Who did you come to Australia with and/or who did you leave behind?

I came to Australia with my husband and 3-year-old son on a ship which docked in Fremantle. We made our way to Melbourne and then finally South Australia where we settled down and grew our family with two more children. It was hard leaving Italy, I left behind my parents and a huge family of 27 cousins, so coming to Australia without them was difficult.

First job you had in Australia

I worked at Myers in the city store as a cleaner, which was a very difficult time for me. The hours were at night and I had 3 young children at home so I would often have to leave to catch the bus before my husband got home from his job

at Mitsubishi. I would leave the kids at home waiting for him to arrive and with no mobile phones to call and check up on them I would spend my shifts at working wondering if everything was ok at home.

I also worked as a dressmaker in Italy, so in Australia I would often do alterations for a shop and sometimes take on private work dressmaking.

What do you enjoy the most about volunteering at the Casa D'Abruzzo-Molise Club?

It's my home! I have been at the Casa D'Abruzzo- Molise Club for 40 years now. I have worked in the kitchen, managed the club and exercise and bocce groups.
